Before Service:

Frank was born 5th April 1914, the son of George and Emma Southern of 1, Braeside Cottages, Elham, Kent. The 1939 Register shows Frank was a Grocer's Assistant and a member of the Elham Auxiliary Fire Service (AFS). Frank married Jessie Cowell in the June quarter of 1937 at Ashford. They lived at 2 Park Lane, Elham.

He joined the AFS with his friend Charlie Goldup and later enlisted in the Oxfordshire and Buckinghamshire Light Infantry

During Service:

Between 17<sup>th</sup> January 1944 and 18<sup>th</sup> May 1944, Monte Cassino and the Gustav defences were assaulted four times by Allied troops. Frank was reported missing and it is presumed that he died of wounds. Died: Wednesday, 16th February 1944. Age 29. Memorial: CASSINO MEMORIAL, Italy Grave Reference/Panel Number: Panel 8 & Elham War Memorial.
