The Elham Historical Study (EHS) has been set up to seek, preserve, inspire and transmit knowledge of the history of the village of Elham.

A working group will meet each month to plan the work, aided by a group of volunteers working on a variety of projects and events.

An important role for the Historical Study is to preserve village documents and artefacts from both the past and the present so that they will be available for future generations.

Projects will include:

- Recording oral histories from residents of the village who have interesting memories to share
- Analysis and Recording of the Elham Census Information
- Recording of all Monumental Inscriptions at Elham's Churches, Cemetery and the War Memorial
- Production of an Elham History Pamphlet together with a Village Walk Guide and Map
